How you can make a donation

If you'd like to make a donation there are several ways you can do this:

1. Through your bank

Make a donation by using the donation form overleaf, or pay direct into our bank using sort code 54-30-64 and account number 42675626.

2. Just Giving fundraising

3. JustTextGiving

Text 'SWYP13' plus the amount you would like to donate (eg. SWYP13 £3) to 70070.

4. Payroll giving

You can donate to Charitable Funds by payroll giving. This reduces your taxable income so you pay less tax as well as giving money to a good cause. Contact your HR or payroll department for more information.

5. Leaving money in your will

Leaving a gift in your will to Charitable Funds is a wonderful way for your generosity to last beyond your lifetime.
