Single sound lotto game

This game is used as a listening activity or a talking activity.

- Print out 2 copies of each sound board
- Cut 1 copy out. Have 1 copy as the lotto sound boards.

Laminate the cards and boards if you like

Listening Activity

- Turn the cards face down and play lotto.
- Take it in turns to turn over a card.
- Say the sound for your child to hear
- Encourage your child to match the card onto the lotto board
- Remember to say the 'pure' sound and not the letter (for example 'fff' not 'feh')
- When the child hears sounds better you can make the game harder. Turn the card over and hide the picture. Ask your child to point to the sound you are saying on 1 of the boards.

Talking Activity

- Turn the cards face down and play lotto
- Take it in turns to turn over a card. When it is your turn model the sound to your child.
- When it is your child's turn encourage them to say the sound
- If your child names the picture, model the sound. See if they can copy
- It doesn't matter if they can't remember the sounds, it is more important to practise copying them.
- Remember always to use the pure sound.
