

Final sound jigsaw game

This game helps children to practice putting sounds on the end of their words.

How to play

















Start with final sound jigsaw 1 pictures.

- Cut out the pictures.
- Put your finger on the left picture. Say the first part of the word.
- Move your finger across the card to say the final sound. Ask your child to copy you and move their finger.
- With lots of practice your child will be able to move their finger themselves. When they can do this ask them to say the whole word themselves.
















When your child gets good at this move onto final sounds jigsaw 2

- Cut out the pictures along the lines.
- Place the picture cards upside down and the final sound cards facing up.
- Let your child pick a picture card and turn it over.
- Say the part of the word on the picture
- Ask your child to find the final sound that goes with the word.
- After your child has done this, model the whole word.
- When your child is able to find the correct sounds ask them to say the whole word. If they make miss the final sound off or say the wrong sound, say it back to them. For example is it a 'bu' or a 'bus'
