Sound Story

This story will help your child to practice saying single sounds.

Each picture has its own sound.

Make the sounds as you read the story.

When your child hears the sounds clearly, they may start to copy them.

Some sounds may be harder for your child.

You can also practice these sounds during play.

Don't worry if it's still hard - just keep saying it the right way yourself.

It will help more if you:

- Read it in a quiet place - switch off the television and radio.
- Make sure your child can see your face and your mouth movements – this will help them to see how to move their mouth and make the

'v.....er.....um'



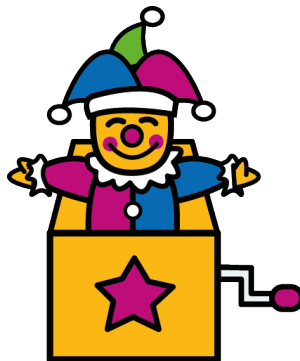
'v.....er....oom'

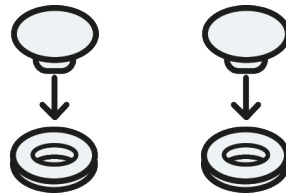
After breakfast you washed your hands and brushed your teeth.
 You turned the tap on. It dripped.



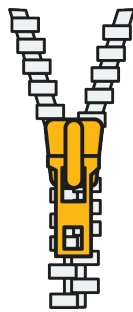

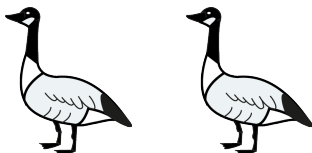
You felt quite hot and thirsty. Mummy bought you an ice lolly.

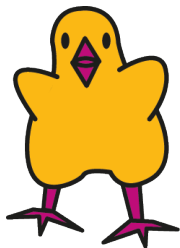

“Oh look” said mummy pointing to some tiny chicks. “Aren’t they sweet” she said.



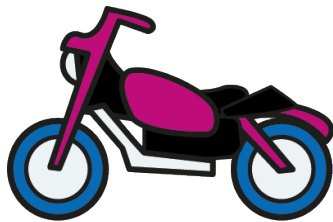

You were tired. It was nearly time to go home. Mummy took you to the shop and you got a toy motorbike.

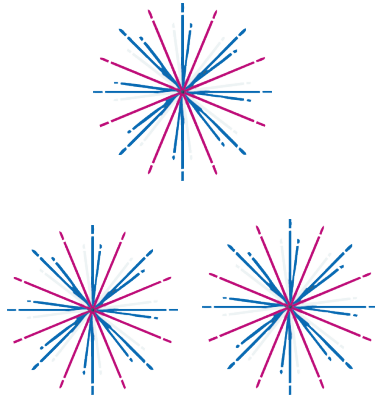
