

Word webs

Lots of children need extra help to learn and remember new words.

Our 'word web' game is a great way to teach new words.

Children learn new words best when they know about both the meaning and sound information of a word. Our word web game helps them to think about both of these things.

• Choose a word to use.

It is helpful to choose a word that your child is learning about at school. For example, a word from their current topic, a word they are using in maths or a word from their spellings. Their teacher can help you choose some helpful words.

- Use the word web questions or put the question cards around the paper.
- Take turns to choose a question to answer. You can answer the same question more than once. For example, if the object is a candle, where you find it: church, a cake, in the bathroom.
- There may be more than one answer to the question.
- You can score points for each answer given. Check who has the most points after 5 questions.

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


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Simple word web cards

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
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


Verb word web cards

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
