- No change to the fence line







## What's different this time?

- Avoid water main






Bretton Centre - Plan as existing.



Bretton Centre - Plan as proposed.





#### **Proposed Materials**

- 1. Wall Brick to match existing
- Wall White Render
- Window Frame Secure Aluminium Dark Grey
- 4. Louvre Grey Aluminium
- Wall Timber Effect Panelling





#### **Proposal Comparison**

- The proposed two storey extension is slightly higher than the existing Oasis Centre.
- The proposed extension is screened by the surrounding green belt and treelines.
- The design will be light and modern to be in keeping with the rest of the surroundings.

#### **Site Comparison**

- Proposed Flat roof will be provided to meet NHS Environmental initiatives to provide Photovoltaic panels and air source heat pumps.
- Enhanced grounds area retaining existing trees to hide the fence and provide screening to the surroundings.
- Retained embankment further obscures the building in combination with point above.
