

## Children's Speech and Language Therapy How to play Happy Families (r blends)

The aim of the game is to get as many Happy Families as possible.

### How to play

Shuffle the cards and place in a pile face down on the table. Each player takes it in turns to pick up a card.

Player 1 picks up a card. They then name the picture. In this example the card is spell. They put the card on the table for everyone to see.



Player 2 takes a card and names the picture. If it is a matching card, they can take the matching card off the other players. In this example player 2 has 2 "spell" cards.












When the (last) card in a family is picked up, that player keeps all 3 cards. They have a Happy Family. No one can take the family of cards off them.

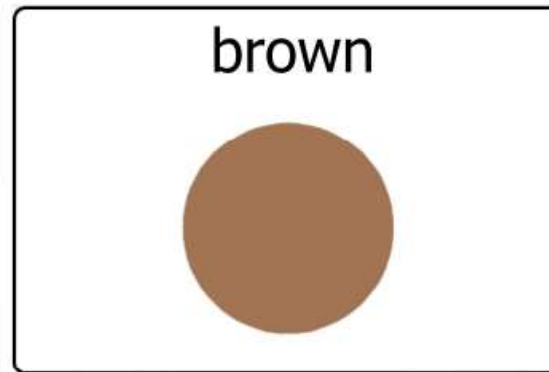
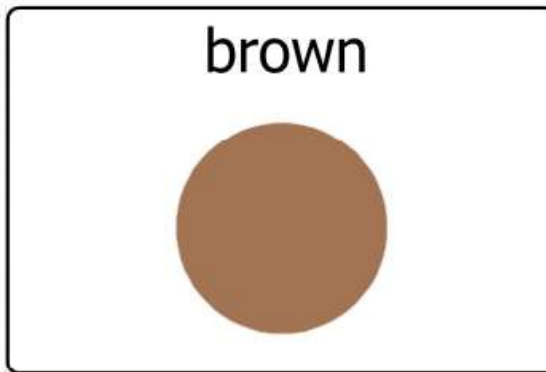
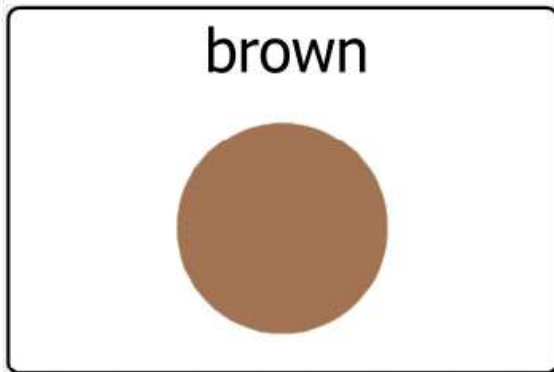
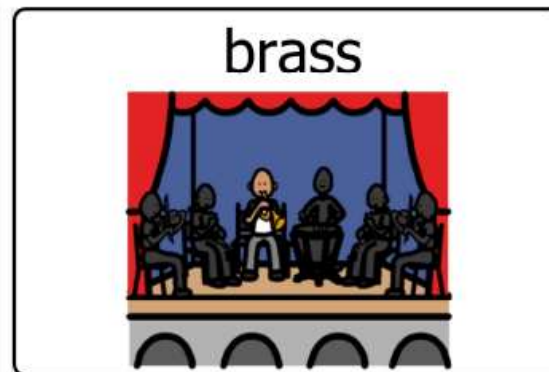
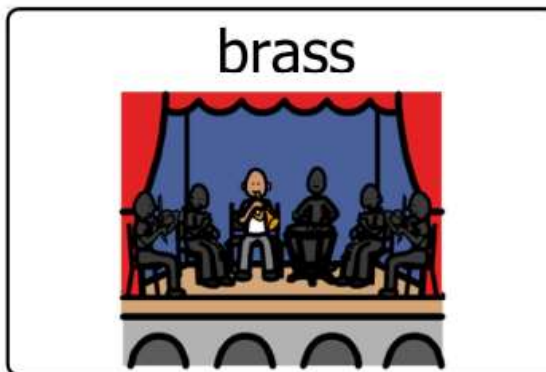
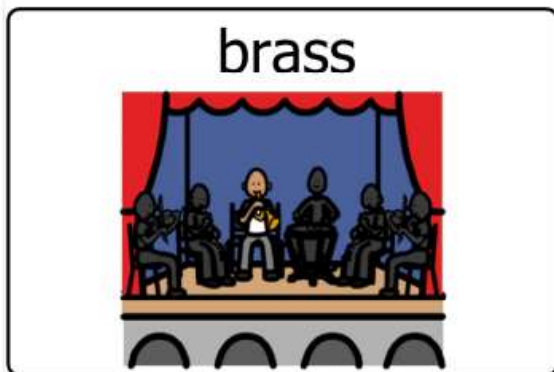
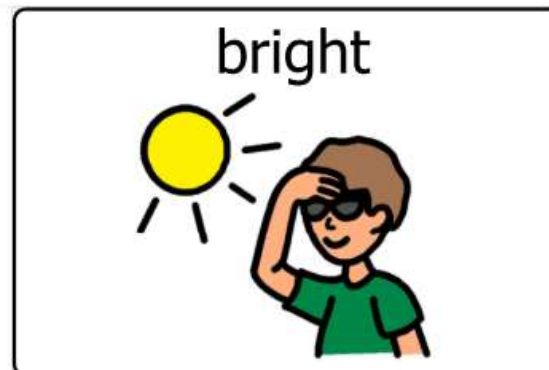
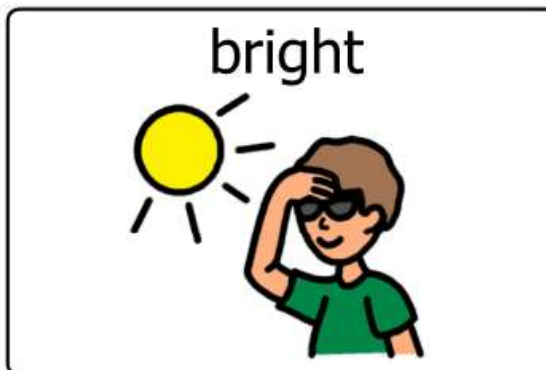
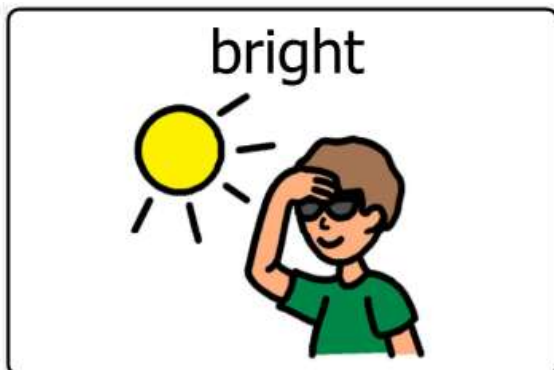


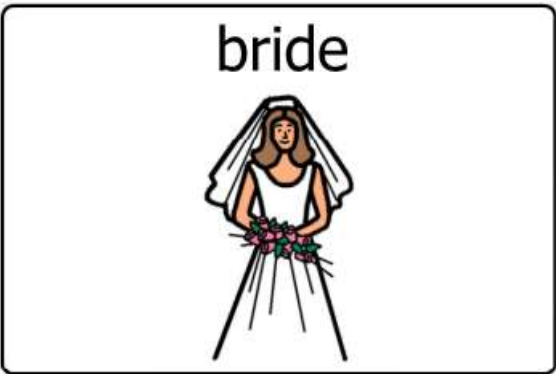
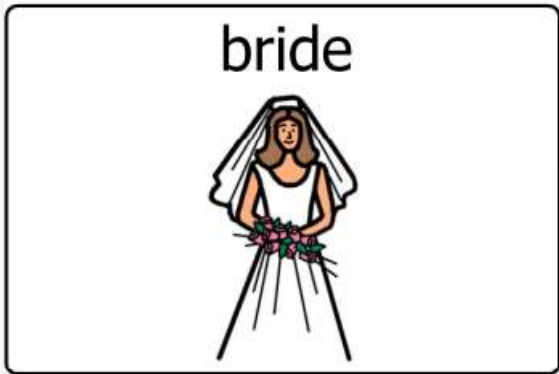
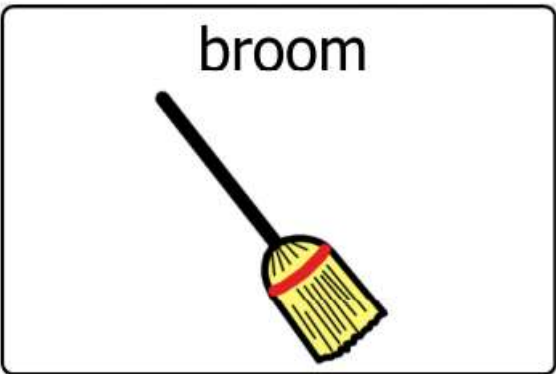
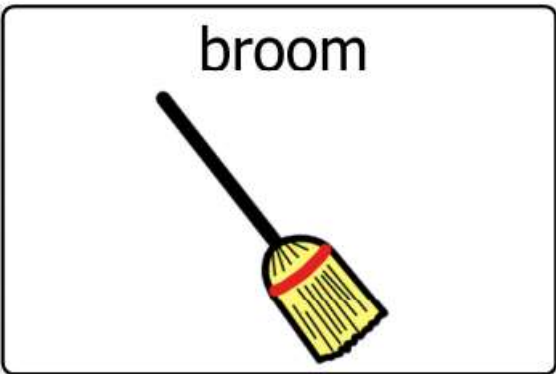
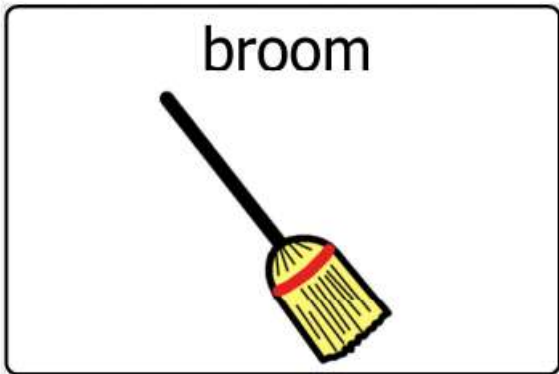
When you have a Happy Family, you repeat the word 3 times – for example – spell, spell, spell.

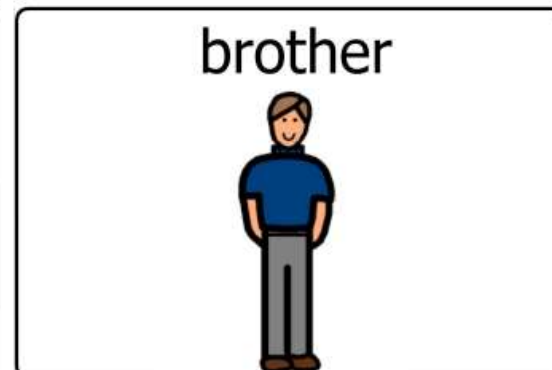
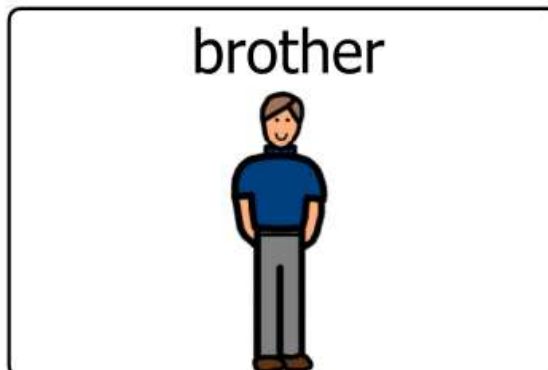
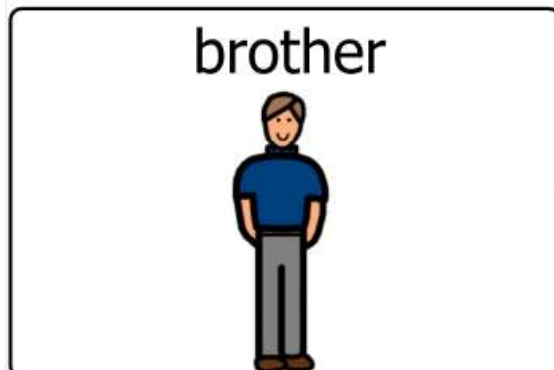
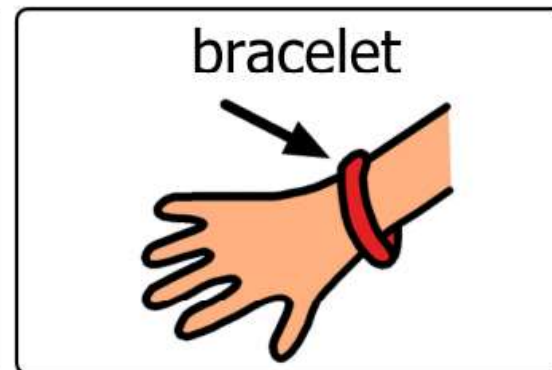
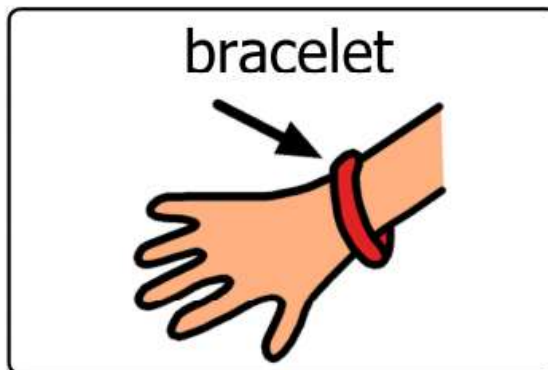
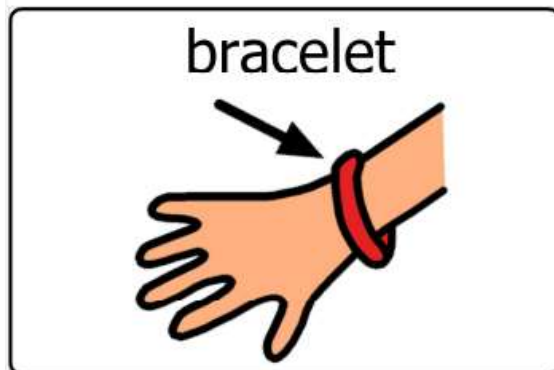
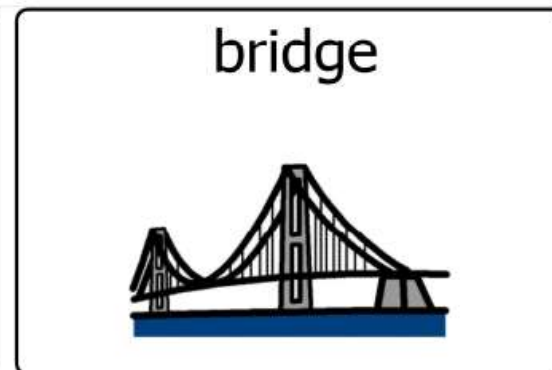
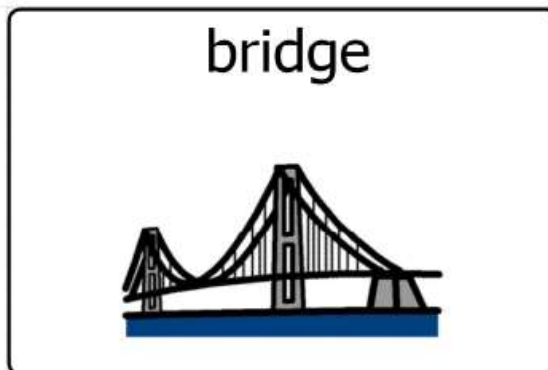
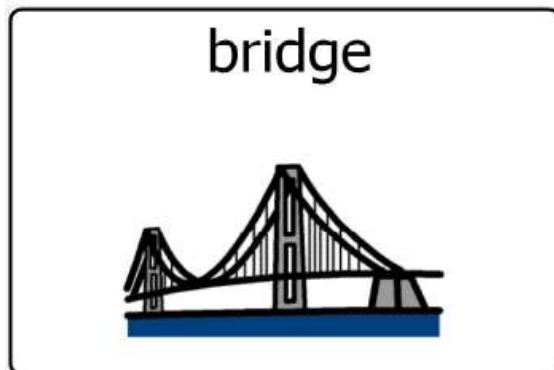
