Stammering - how to help children in nursery and schools

Who it's for? Teaching assistants, practitioners, teachers and other professionals working with children who stammer.

This is a free half day course from 9.30am to 12.30pm.

What will you learn about?

- What stammering is, including hidden stammering and the impact it may have on a person's education
- Causes of stammering
- What are challenges for children who stammer in school
- How to help support stammering
- Acceptance of stammering as a different way of talking



Building vocabulary skills

Who is it for? Parents and carers, teaching assistants, practitioners, teachers and other professionals working with children with vocabulary difficulties

This is a free half day course from 9.30am to 12.30 pm.

What is the training like?

People find this course very practical and good fun and say they get great ideas to take away and use

They get to think about how we learn words and what can help.

Topics covered:

- How we learn vocabulary
- Normal vocabulary development
- Why some children have difficulties
- Games and ideas for supporting and helping vocabulary skills



Phonology (speech and pronunciation difficulties)

Who is it for? professionals and parents/carers who support children who have difficulties with the pronunciation of sounds when they are talking and live within the Barnsley area. This course is most useful for activities and advice for children aged three years and over.

This is a free two day course from 9.30am to 3.00pm.

What is the training like?

People find this course very interesting, useful and fun. They think about sounds and words in a different way and learn practical ways to help children who have pronunciation difficulties. They also learn how to work out when children need help and need to see a speech and language therapist.

Topics covered:

Day 1: Understanding speech sound difficulties

- Normal speech sound development
- Speech sound delay and disorder
- The causes and impacts of speech sound difficulties
- How to screen for speech sound difficulties
- Phonological awareness



Day 2: Helping children with speech sound difficulties

- Effective approaches in helping children
- Practical ideas for carrying out speech sound work with children
- Therapy techniques used with children
- Delivering speech and language therapy programmes



Helping children understand questions

Who is it for? professionals and parents of children who need support in understanding language and questions.

This is a free 2 hour course from 9.30am to 11.30 am.

Topics covered:

- How knowing a child's level of question understanding will support them at home and in the classroom
- The four different levels of questions, using the Blank levels of questioning model
- How to target different levels of questioning within an activity
- Assessing a child's level of question understanding to support them at home and in the classroom
- Practising the 4 levels





Elklan speech and language support for 3 to 5s

Cost: £140 per participant for the 11 week course.

Elklan communication support for 0-25s with complex needs
